This month is flying by! 4th grade has been up to SO much!

In **Reading**, we have been working to summarize nonfiction texts. We know that good summaries always include the main idea of a text, as well as many supporting details which tell us more about the main idea. We have also learned about nonfiction text features and how to use them to enhance our nonfiction reading.

In **Writing**, we have finished creating our nonfiction feature articles! Each student researched an animal and created an informative article to teach about their topic. Feature articles will go home at conferences so your child can share their hard work with you!

In **Math**, we have been working on multi-digit addition and subtraction. We have also begun to learn multi-digit multiplication using the Box Method. All of these new math skills will help us complete our summative project where students are planning and budgeting for a cross country road trip!

In **Science**, we have concluded our unit on systems, and students presented their human body system projects to the class! Students were able to explain their system, the system's parts, and each part's function. As well as tell what they thought would happen if a part was missing from their system, based on their research.

In **Social Studies**, we have been immersing ourselves in the topic of innovation! We have learned about important innovative thinkers, leaders, ideas, and inventions. Students are now working to brainstorm innovations they would like to research for their social studies projects.

4th grade is also focusing on being a bully free classroom. We have been working to learn about how to be an upstander and not a bystander, and how to be a good friend to our peers.

Many students in our classroom are also participating in Musical Theater Club! We are very excited for their upcoming performance!

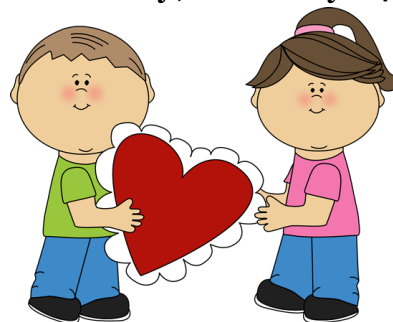
Parent Teacher Conferences

There are 20 students in our class.

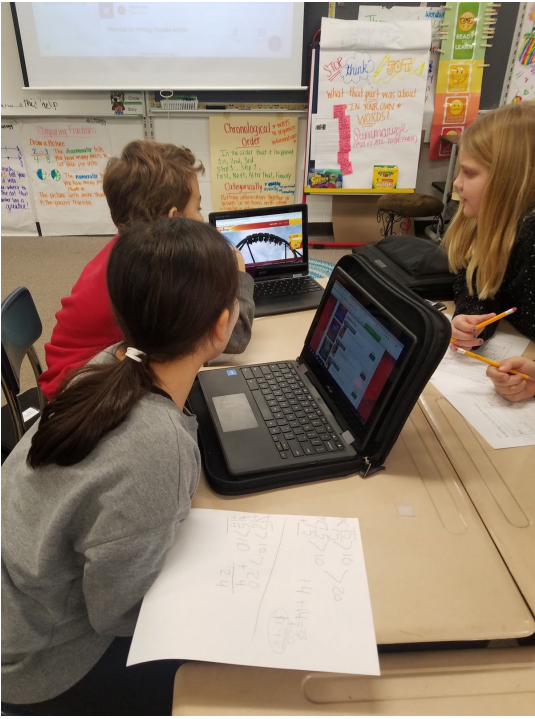

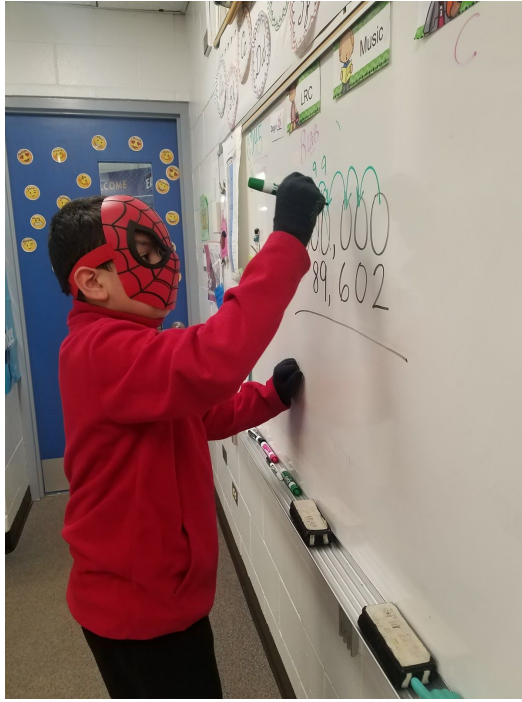
