wow! Can you believe 4th grade is almost over!? As usual, Miss Romano's class has been very busy! We had an awesome field trip to the bowling alley with Coach G., and we are learning lots of new things in the classroom!

In **Math** we completed our Measurement and Geometry units where we learned about lines, angles, and classifying shapes, as well as converting inches and feet, and calculating area and perimeter. We have been working on Box Method Long Division and Decimal Place Value. We will continue working with these concepts until the end of the year, including comparing decimals and fractions. We will also be revisiting math concepts from earlier in the year!

In our **Reader's and Writer's Workshops** we have completed our literary essays, and are now learning all about Poetry. Students are studying poems to identify features, as well as writing poems of their own! Students will be creating poetry books to bring home at the end of the year.

In **Science** we are becoming engineers! Students are learning about different types of simple machines and creating some of their own! We are also testing our designs and collecting data to help us improve our designs with each trial.

Students in 4th grade are also concluding their **cursive lessons**. They will receive a special certificate from our board member and cursive teacher, Mrs. "Shoes" on **Friday, May 25th**.

I have had an absolutely fabulous year teaching 4th grade! This will be my last edition of *The Romano Report* this year, but I will send any additional updates home as needed. Have a terrific summer!
